The warranty period commences on the date recorded on the Caribou sales invoice.

The warranty only covers products sold through approved Caribou distributors, agents or resellers.

The warranty only covers the purchaser against manufacturing defaults.

The warranty only covers products that have been installed correctly by qualified installers.

Warranty covers products used as they are designed to be used, and what could reasonably be considered normal use.

Warranty will not cover products that have been operated outside of their specified suitable environment.

Warranty will not cover products that have operated at incorrect voltages

Warranty will not cover products that have been modified on-site. Warranty will not cover products that have been modified after purchase from Caribou.

All warranty claims must have a valid proof of purchase.

All warranty claims must have a genuine reason for warranty claim. All goods replaced by warranty must be returned to Caribou for assessment of failure.

Any labour, access or site related costs to remove or assess the warranty claim are not covered under warranty.

Caribou reserves the right to repair or replace any items deemed faulty by assessment.

Any goods replaced or repaired under warranty will have their warranty expire on the same date as the original items warranty period

A security deposit of up to \$200 per fitting may be required if the faulty fitting cannot be returned for assessment before a replacement is issued.

Warranty does not extend to the following:

- Flickering lights as a result from input voltage, frequency, cable connections, dimmers, sensors, accessories or any other component outside of the Caribou Lighting product range.
